Any of my yearlings that do not make the final cut for the Premium Gold Sale are to be transferred to the _____ sale.

1. The Premium Gold Sale conducted on Friday evening will be limited to 70 pacing yearlings plus no more than 5 trotting yearlings. 2. APG will select what it deems to be the best 70-75 yearlings for the Premium Gold Sale based on pedigree, confirmation and type. Following the close of nominations on 30 June 2009, an APG appointed selection committee will rank and possibly cull the nominations based on pedigree. An independent APG appointed panel will then inspect lots that remain in contention for the Premium Gold Sale with a view to ranking lots based on conformation and type. The decisions of APG in selecting what it deems to be the 70 best yearlings for the Premium Gold Sale based on the nominations received will be final and no correspondence will be entered into. The \$330 (GST inclusive) Nomination Fee is non refundable and Vendors must indicate into which APG Sale they wish their yearling to be entered if not selected for the Premium Gold Sale. The order of cataloguing will be determined by APG. The decisions of APG will be final. 3. All Yearlings in the Premium Gold Sale must be filmed for inclusion on the APG website and Sales DVD. APG will charge the vendor any costs associated with the production & distribution of the DVD. 4. The 10% APG Commission is applicable to a yearling catalogued for the Premium Gold Sale and subsequently sold by the Vendor privately or at auction prior to the Premium Gold Sale. 5. If, at the sales complex prior to the Premium Gold Sale an APG accredited agent inspects a yearling and is of the opinion that a yearling is not presented to a satisfactory standard then that yearling will be withdrawn from the Premium Gold Sale and included in an alternative APG Sale (e.g. Melbourne Sale on Sunday, 7th February 2010). All Premium Gold Yearlings are to be available for inspection at the Inglis Sale Complex no later than 12 noon on Thursday, 4th February 2010. 6. The Upset Price for each Yearling in the Premium Sale will be \$10,000. 7. If a Premium sale yearling is retained by the Vendor the Purchaser Sustaining Fee of \$951:50 will be charged to the Vendor's account. All Premium Gold Yearlings must be sustained on sales day for the Race Series. 8. Conditions 1 to 7 of the Premium Gold Sale are to be considered in conjunction with the APG Terms & Conditions of Sale which are printed on the reverse of the Nomination Form and appear in the APG Series Twenty-one catalogues.
