

## Could this be the Strongest Crop of APG 2yo's in History?

With this season's 2yo racing now in full swing, APG Graduates have stamped themselves as the horses to follow in the feature races.

Heading the list, is **Cuttheattitude**, the son of Modern Art who's seasons earnings have now topped the \$200,000 mark thanks to his bold, all-the-way victory in the recent APG 2yo Series Final for Colts & Geldings.

Trained by Felicity Gallagher, **Cuttheattitude** was purchased by Greg & Mandy Targett for \$13,500 at the 2008 APG Sydney Sale.

In taking out the Group One feature, **Cuttheattitude** defeated what is arguably the most outstanding group of 2-year-old colts ever to graduate from the APG sales.

His scalps on the night included Bathurst Gold Crown champion, **Chariot King**, the immensely talented Art Major duo **For A Reason** and **Renaissance Man**, and the high class Artesian colt, **Jorg Is Best**.

Between them, these five horses have already won 25 races and over \$500,000 in earnings.

Over in Western Australia, **David Hercules** is flying the flag for the APG horses. An APG eligible entry in the 2008 WA National Sale, **David Hercules** has already won two Group races and over \$80,000 in stakes.

Fillies from the 2008 APG Sales have also been prolific winners, headed by **Mach And Me**, the diminutive daughter of Mach Three who flew home from three back the pegs, to capture the Group One APG Fillies Series from **Modern Girl** and **Rocknrolla**.

Gallant in defeat, **Modern Girl** already has five wins and over \$100,000 in prize money to her name, while **Rocknrolla** has only tasted defeat once in her six starts to date, and many people are tipping her to be one of the leading contenders for this year's Breeders Crown.

As at the 22<sup>nd</sup> of May, the leading five 2 year old money earners in Australia are all APG graduates, with over \$650,000 of earnings between them.
